 - a. Progressive education fits with our mission to build thoughtful, creative learners

- b. Taking kids seriously using students' first names to promote the concepts of mutual respect. Engaging them in learning; showing the dignity of everyone and what they bring to their learning. How well do our students know this information about progressive learning and project based?

 - Specifics how to incorporate the immersive community learning experiences throughout the year (not just opening and May term)
 - Mid-year reflection on social contract
 - Specific On-boarding to social contract with new to school students (and new within year). From student to student, or deliberate observations to see demonstration of the social norm
 - Resiliency and culture to take responsible risk taking -
 - Use "I survived" shared examples from older students in advisory circle time - sharing stories of failure, and renaming failure to be accountability and learning
 - Reflection on the process, learning and challenges between peers for projects
 - Use of peers to for project progress check-ins, providing feedback to peers
